Inspect, Detect, Protect against Carbon Monoxide Poisoning

Carbon monoxide (CO) is a highly poisonous gas which can be produced in your home by faulty gas appliances.

You can't see it. You can't taste it. You can't even smell it. But carbon monoxide can kill without warning in a very short time, even while you sleep.

IMPORTANT

There have been two incidences of carbon monoxide poisoning in Grand Union Village in the last few weeks as a result of disconnected gas flues. From a health and safety perspective, you are therefore very strongly recommended to ensure that you have a Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarm installed in your home. The safety of you and your family is our absolute priority. - Headaches
- Dizziness
- Nausea
- Breathlessness
- Collapse
- Loss of Consciousness

If you experience any symptoms of Carbon Monoxide Poisoning, you need to:

- Get fresh air immediately. Open doors and windows, turn off gas appliances and leave the house
- See your doctor immediately or go to hospital
- If you think there is immediate danger, call the Gas Emergency Helpline Tel: 0800 111 999
- Get a Gas Safe registered engineer to inspect your gas appliances and flues to see if there is a dangerous problem

Be sure you:

- Have a registered Gas Safe engineer inspect and service your gas boiler system every year
- Install CO alarms
- Test your CO alarm regularly
